NOTE: stars indicate the rough location of clumps of narcissi

- A** *Corylopsis pauciflora* **x1** The buttercup winter hazel is a spreading shrub that bears pale yellow flowers. 1.8m high by 2.1m wide.
- B** *Cenolophium denudatum* **x10** Dark, fern-like foliage in spring, soft flower heads in summer. 1.2m.
- C** *Fritillaria persica* 'Adiyaman' **x7-15** This Persian lily has bell-shaped, brown-purple flowers. 1.5m.
- D** *Brunnera macrophylla* **x8** This false forget-me-not bears clouds of bright blue flowers. 45cm high.
- E** *Milium effusum* 'Aureum' **x8** Bowles's golden grass has rich yellow leaves. 60cm.
- F** *Narcissus* 'Jenny' **x25** (orange stars) ★ Has swept-back petals and a lemon-yellow trumpet that fades to cream. 25cm.
- G** *Helleborus x hybridum* **x9** The classic Lenten rose flowers between midwinter and mid-spring. 45cm.
- H** *Epimedium x perralchicum* 'Fröhnleiten' **x12** (green tinted area) ◻ This barrenwort bears bright yellow flowers above dark green foliage. 30cm.
- I** *Primula vulgaris* **x12** (cream area) ◻ Pale yellow, scented flowers. 5cm.
- J** *Anemone nemorosa* **x25** (cream area) ◻ The wood anemone has simple white or pink-flushed flowers. 5cm.
- K** *Digitalis lutea* **x11** The small yellow foxglove flowers from early to midsummer. 60cm.
- L** *Euphorbia amygdaloides* var. *robbiae* **x7** Mrs Robb's bonnet bears bright green flower heads. 60cm.
- M** *Narcissus* 'Hawera' **x35** (purple stars) ★ Each bulb produces multiple blooms. 18cm.
- N** *Paeonia mlokosewitschii* **x6** Large, single lemon-yellow flowers. 60cm.
- O** *Deschampsia cespitosa* 'Goldschleier' **x8** This grass has dark green leaves and pale golden spikelets. 75cm.
- P** *Galanthus nivalis* **x35** (green striped area) ◻ The common snowdrop produces honey-scented blooms all winter. 15cm.
- Q** *Lilium martagon* **x5-15** The Turk's cap lily produces strongly scented flowers in early to midsummer. 1.5m.
